Quail hunting is really the highlight of what we do. With our mule-drawn wagons and hunting dogs, we take you to a different place and time. Along our two-mile course in a pine forest of gentle, rolling hills, you will have the quail hunting experience of a lifetime.

Typically, our guests arrive in the afternoon and can get in a little skeet shooting. That is followed by dinner and a relaxing evening in our lodge. In the morning, there can be more skeet shooting prior to the 9 a.m. start of the hunt that usually lasts three to 3½ hours. Then it is back to the lodge for lunch before the afternoon round of hunting.
